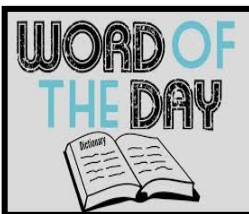
We have reached the nadir of attendance due to the effects of the Coronavirus.

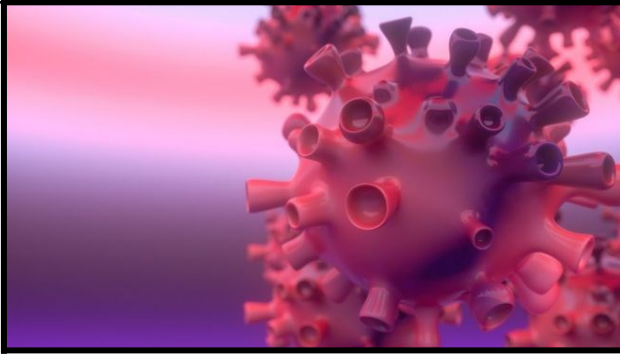
