

# Year One Weekly update

It has been another great week in Year One. I look forward to seeing and talking to you all at the parents meeting on Monday 17th September 2018.

## Maths

This week we learnt to count forwards and backwards from 0 – 10. Counting backwards was a challenge but we tried our best and now most of us can do it! We completed lots of independent challenges in the maths area this week for example representing numbers in a tens frame.

## Topic

This week we learnt about the seasons and different types of weather. We are now able to name and describe lots of different weather types - sunny is our favourite!

We created class rules in PSHE and understand rules keep us safe.

We also learnt about toys from the past and discussed which toys we would like to play with. Most of us really liked the skateboard and Rubix cube.

In Music we learnt a song about the weather.

English: This week we found 33 coupons in our classroom! We also found an advert which explained the coupons were for a Turbodog toy. We wrote letters to the company who gave us the coupons and hope to have our own Turbodog soon! (However the advert said that delivery is a very very long wait). We used our finger spaces to write the address on the envelope and posted the letter in the post box by school. We also drew pictures of Turbodog following clear instructions. ## Phonics

This week we revised reading and writing words with f and s sound spelt using ff and ss. We also continued to learn to read new common exception words like school and house. Next week we will be learning to read and write words with /l/, /k/ and /z/ sounds spelt using 'll', 'ck' and 'zz'.
