English

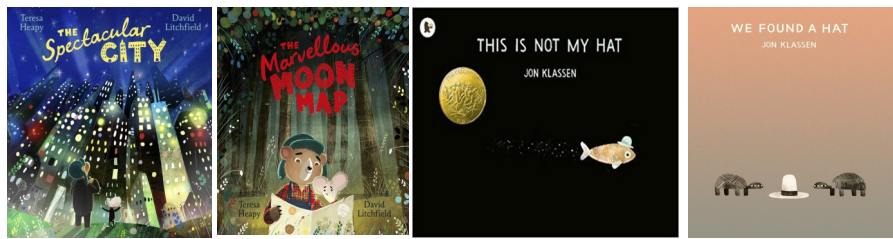
