Maths:

This week we have been learning about place value and how to partition two digit numbers into tens and ones and what each number in a 2-digit number is worth.

Next week we will continue our learning about place-value and we will be

Phonics / Spellings :

This week we have been learning how to use our spelling journals and different techniques for learning new words. We also learnt about homophones , in particular see and sea.

Next week we will be learning further strategies for learning new spellings.

English:

This week we have continued our learning on Bob, Man on the Moon by Simon Bartram. We have learning about adjectives and expanded noun phrases to describe.

Next week we will continue to work on this book and we will be designing posters with rules for behaviour on the moon. We will also be designing our own aliens who will feature in stories

Topic:

Our topic this term is 'Our City, Our Story' when we will be learning about London's history, beginning with The Great Fire of London. This week we have been comparing present day London to London in 1666. We have also been learning how to locate London on a map of the World and of the UK. In Science we have been thinking about the properties of materials and what everyday objects are made of.

Next week we will be thinking about life in the 17th century and comparing it to present day life in London. We will also be learning about London Landmarks. In Science we will be continuing
