

# Year Two Weekly update



Friday 28th September

Messages: It is important that you child does their homework as it supports their learning in class. We try to make sure it is easily accessible and not too onerous. Please help and support your child to complete it. We have Homework club on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday lunchtime and if the children do not do their homework they will be expected to attend one of the sessions to complete it at school.

## Maths:

This week we have been learning how to count in 2s and 5s from 0 and in 10s from any number. We have also been learning how to count in 3s from 0.

Next we will be learning about addition and subtraction facts to 20. We will also be learning how to use these facts to check answers and learning related facts eg; if  $4 + 6 = 10$ , then  $14 + 6 = 20$ .

## Phonics / Spellings ;

This week we have been learning how to spell some of our common exception words - we have also been learning how to use GPC charts.

Next week we will continue to learn some more common exception words, including some from the Y1 list—these are words that occur frequently in the children's writing and they should be able to spell.

Well done to everyone who tried hard learning their spellings last week ! 😊

## English:

This week we have continued working on the book Bob, Man on the Moon. We have been writing our own stories about our own characters we have been developing.

Next week we will be starting work on a new book, Here Comes Traction Man. We will begin by thinking about what we can find out about the book by using the pictures for clues. Please dont read this book with your child as it needs to be new to them when we start.

## Topic:

In topic we have been learning about the order of events during the Great Fire of London and the children have been ordering these events. We also learnt how to use a map to give instructions. In Science we have been learning about suitability of materials for different purposes.

Next week we will be learning about geographical features and which ones you could expect to see in London. In History the children will be leaning about Samuel Pepys' diaries and how we know about the Great Fire Of London In Science we will be learning how to distinguish objects from materials.

Homework: I have reset the Mathletics for those who did not do it this week and some more for those who did. Please complete this and do the reading eggs activity that I have set for homework. Your logins for both are in your homework folders.
