The cat purred.</p> <p>A compound sentence is formed when you join two main clauses with a conjunction. In a compound sentence the clauses are linked by coordinating conjunctions (for, and, nor but, or, yet, so,). For example, I like bananas and I like grapes.</p> <p>A complex sentence is formed when you join a main clause and a subordinate clause with a conjunction. A subordinate clause is one that relies on a main clause to make sense.
