Spellings: *Suffix -ous, using -cious and -tious:*

- (ambition) ambitious

Rules: Adding the vowel suffix **ous**, as **ci**ous or **ti**ous, turns a **noun** into an **adjective**. There are not many words that end like this and many just have to be learnt. One exception to this is the word **anxious**.

Drop a final **e** before adding **ci**ous to words ending **ce**. There are exceptions, e.g. **conscience** -
