After half term we will be finding one more and one less than numbers up to 50. We will also be comparing objects and numbers up to 50 using practical resources.

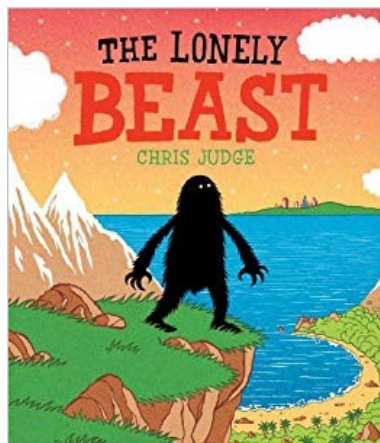
## Phonics / Spellings
