Messages:

Maths:

This week we have finished Block 4 numbers to 20. We compared objects and numbers. We also ordered objects and numbers to 20 using the greater than, less than and equal to symbols.

Next week we will be starting Block 5 addition and subtraction to 20. We will start by looking at adding numbers by counting on.

Phonics / Spellings ;

This week we have been looking and comparing the alternative spellings for the sounds ir/er/ur, oe/oa, oy/oi and ou/ow.

Next week will be investigating the alternative spellings for ie (ie, igh, i - e and y). We will also be looking at the alternative spellings for ee (ee, ea, ey and y).

English:

This week we have continued our new book 'BEEGU' by Alexis Deacon. The children have enjoyed writing about Beegu's home planet and acting out in role.

Next week we will be creating story maps to help us retell the story of Beegu in our own words. We will be focusing on using story language and a range of sentence starters.

Topic:

This week the children learnt the names of simple everyday materials. They also discussed what toys are made from.

Next week the children will be discussing the properties of materials. We will also be explaining why they are suited for different toys for example why teddy bears are not made from glass. We will also be drawing our own toys in Art and looking at puppets in DT.

Homework: This week please complete the work set on Mathematics.

REMEMBER it is the Science fair next week and homework was to produce a project to take to the hosting school.

Teachers will be judging this next week so all projects **MUST** be into school on Monday !
