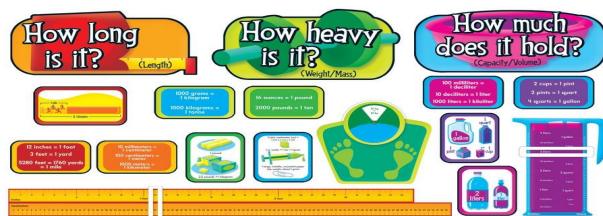
Messages:

Maths

This week we continued to learn how to read measurements from a ruler. We also solved problems involving length and height.

Next week we will be taking part in phonics and reading assessments to see how many words we have learnt since the last check. We have made great progress and everyone's reading has come on immensely.

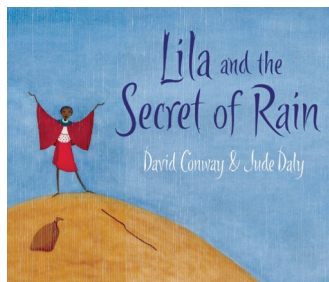
English
