Maths

This week we counted up to 50 and represented numbers up to 50 using practical resources. We focused on understanding the place value of two digit numbers.

Next week we will continue to work on numbers to 50 and explore the place value of these numbers in a range of ways. We will be learning to use stem sentences to help us explain our thinking.

Phonics / Spellings

This week we revised the sounds ph, wh and ew. We are very confident reading words with these sounds but still need some help to use them in our writing.

Next week will be taking part in a range of phonics assessments to see all the new sounds we have learnt this term. Once all the assessments have been completed we will send home a pack for you to practice.

English

This week we wrote postcards in the role of Beegu to the children of Earth. We also wrote book reviews to say we liked about the story and what we did not like.

Next week we will be completing all our writing through our topic sessions.



Topic:

This week learnt about the 7 continents and where the UK is in the world. We also took part in an internet safety workshop on Tuesday. We investigated the question 'Would you rather be a giant or a mouse?' in our big thinking session.

Next week we will be describing materials according to their properties and describing why some materials suit certain objects better than others. We will also be looking at Jewish special objects in RE. As well as the significance of statues in many religions.
