Maths

This week we ordered numbers up to 50. We also counted forwards and backwards in both 2's and 5s using practical resources, hundred squares and in our heads.

Next week we will be starting a new block length and height. This block will start by comparing length and height and then move on to measuring length and height using both informal and formal methods of measuring.

Phonics / Spellings

This week we practised au in launch and ey in key. We also revised aw in saw. We are working hard on our alternative spellings and can now read more words independently.

Next week we will be revising ir, er and ur and learning the best bet rules for when to use each diagraph. We will also practice reading both real and fake words with each of these diagraphs in.

English

We have been very busy celebrating English Week this week and have completed lots of writing activities. First we wrote descriptions of the Beast using similes to make our writing more exciting. Next we sequenced pictures of the Beasts dangerous journey. Then we wrote a newspaper report using our story maps to help us.
