## Maths

This week we finished our addition and subtraction unit. We are now much more confident answering addition and subtraction sums with numbers up to 20.

Next week we will starting our next unit numbers to 50. We will be investigating the place value of numbers up to 50 and discussing how many tens and ones. For example 35 is made up of 3 tens and 5 ones.

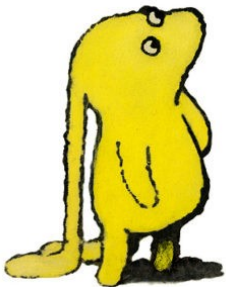
## Phonics / Spellings

This week we learnt the spelling rule for -tch or ch in words like *witch* and *pinch*. We also focused on sounding out carefully especially words that end in 'er' (for example *worker*, *painter*, *helper* etc) Please continue to practice this at home with your child.

Next week will be revising the *ph*, *wh* and *ew* alternative spelling sounds.

## English

This week we wrote and illustrated our own Beegu stories. Beegu crashed into lots of places including Hollickwood School, LegoLand and the ocean. The children used the style of the original story to help structure their adaptations.

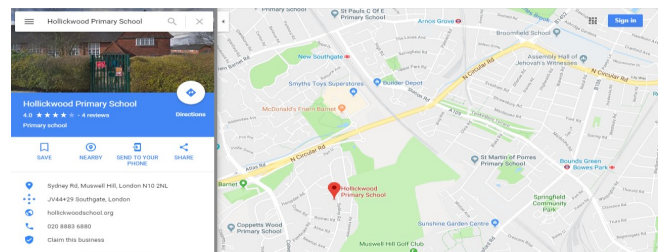


Next week we will be finishing off our book Beegu. We will be answering questions about the text and expressing our likes and dislikes about the story.
