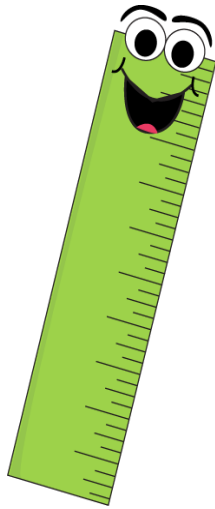
Assembly : Our class assembly is next week - Friday 29th March at 2:45pm.

Next week we will continue to learn to use rulers and read measurements off them. We will also be learning to solve problems involving length and



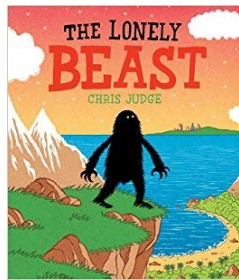
## Phonics / Spellings
