Maths

This week we have started our addition and subtraction unit. We added by counting on, found and made number bonds to 20 and also added by making 10.

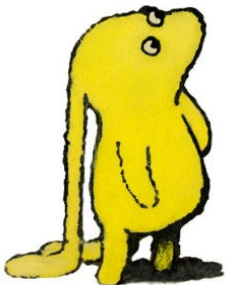
Next week we will be focusing on subtraction. First when not crossing 10 and then by crossing 10. We will also be comparing number sentences using the greater than, less than and equal to signs.

Phonics / Spellings

This week we have learnt the alternative spellings for igh and ee. We also practised our Y1 common exception words. This week every child has different spelling words (words they cannot yet spell from the Y1 CEW list). Next week they will be tested again to check they have learnt them. Next week will be learning er at the end of words and the ch spelt ch and tch.

English

This week we have continued our new book - 'Beegu'. This week we made story maps to retell the story by sequencing the illustrations from the text in the right order. We also wrote the story independently during our big write session.



Next week we will be writing postcards in role as Beegu to the children on Earth. We will also be planning our own fantasy stories about Beegu.

Topic:

This week we continued to learn different sewing stitches in our DT session. We explored the question Can you ever have peace without fighting in P4C. In science we separated objects and materials and discussed each materials properties.

Next week we will be designing and starting to make our own glove puppets in DT. We will discuss what materials to use and why they are best suited. We will try to use scientific language in our discussions.
