Phonics / Spellings

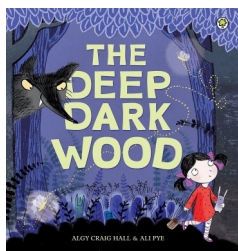
This week we revised our Phase 5 phonemes with a phonics check. Please check your child's homework folder to find any phonemes/words your child needs to practise.

This week we edited and improved our Rabbit and Bear stories. We are very proud of them and enjoyed sharing them with each other!

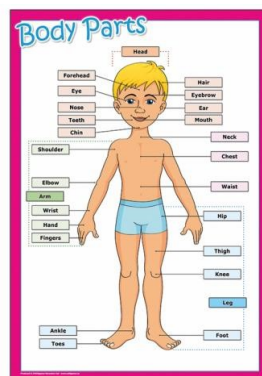
