Phonics / Spellings

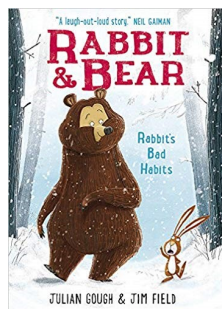
This week we revisited the aw, ue and ew sounds.
