Next week we will be revising identifying Phase 5 phonemes in words.

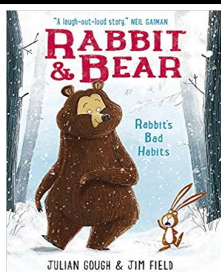
If you need help supporting your child with phonics at home you could watch Mr Thorne on Youtube.
