This week we consolidated our understanding of subtraction to 20. Next week we will be learning related number facts and comparing number sentences.

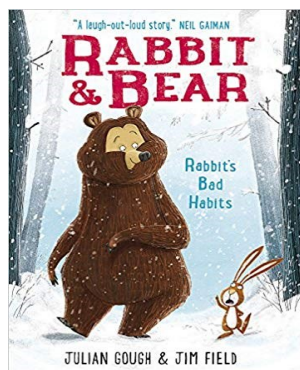
We still need lots of practise remembering our number bonds to 10 and 20. Please practise this at home.

This week we practised identifying Phase 5 phonemes in words. We focused on oa (in the middle) and ow (at the end) of words. English

This week we finished reading the story. We created story maps for our own Rabbit & Bear adventures.
