Maths:

This week we have been learning how to recognise non-unit fractions such as 3/4 and 2/3. We have also been ;earning how to find 3/4 and 2/3 of an amount.

Next week will be doing assessments all week so we will not be following any maths topic. This is so we can assess what the children know and where are areas of weakness are so we can address them after the holidays.

Phonics / Spellings;

This week we have been learning about possessive apostrophes. We have been learning that when you are writing about someones possession then you use an apostrophe before the 's'. We have also learnt that if you are talking about the possession of multiple things or people then you use the apostrophe after the s. For instance; If there are two cats then you would write, the cats' dinner.

Next week we will be assessing the childrens progress with their common exception words. We will assess the Y2 and Y1 words and for some children the Y3/4 words.

English:

This week we have written some non-fiction writing about Neil Armstrong and published this onto our own astronaut books.

Next week we will be using this time to assess ther children writing skills and to conference with each child and explain tot them what they need to do to improve their writing further,.

Topic:

This week we have continues our learning about explorers, in particular Neil Armstrong. In Science we have also designed comic strips and posters to show how a plant grows. In Computing the children published their own information booklet about Neil Armstrong.
