



- New Zealand is an island country in the southwestern Pacific Ocean. It comprises two main landmasses—the North Island and the South Island—and around 600 smaller islands, covering a total area of 268,021 square kilometres.

- Population: 4.886 million (2018)




An earthquake is the sudden movement of the Earth's tectonic plates, resulting in shaking of the ground.



New Zealand earthquake 2011

- Every year GNS Science locates over 15,000 earthquakes in New Zealand. About 100 - 150 of these quakes are large enough to be felt, - the others we only know about because they are recorded by seismographs.
- While the 2010 earthquake was larger, the 2011 earthquake was more devastating in Christchurch City. Most of the 185 people who died in the 2011 quake were killed in collapsed buildings.
- Japan has the most recorded earthquakes in the world

Lost cloth of dreams/Step 2: write the ingredients for magic thread on your piece of cloth.


To fix a magic dream cloth, we would need to use magic thread to sew it back together... and we would need to become dream makers so that we can use the thread.
