Regulating Emotions

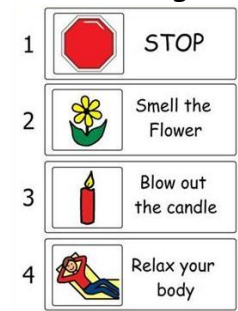
We are encouraging the children to name their emotions, starting with happy, sad and angry and have used some simple emotion characters to support their

A huge thank you to all the parents who have donated items from our wish list. We will need some more items in the new year especially tissues, for the continual runny noses!

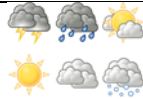
Please have a look at the list outside the classroom and if you are able to buy just one item it would be hugely appreciated.
